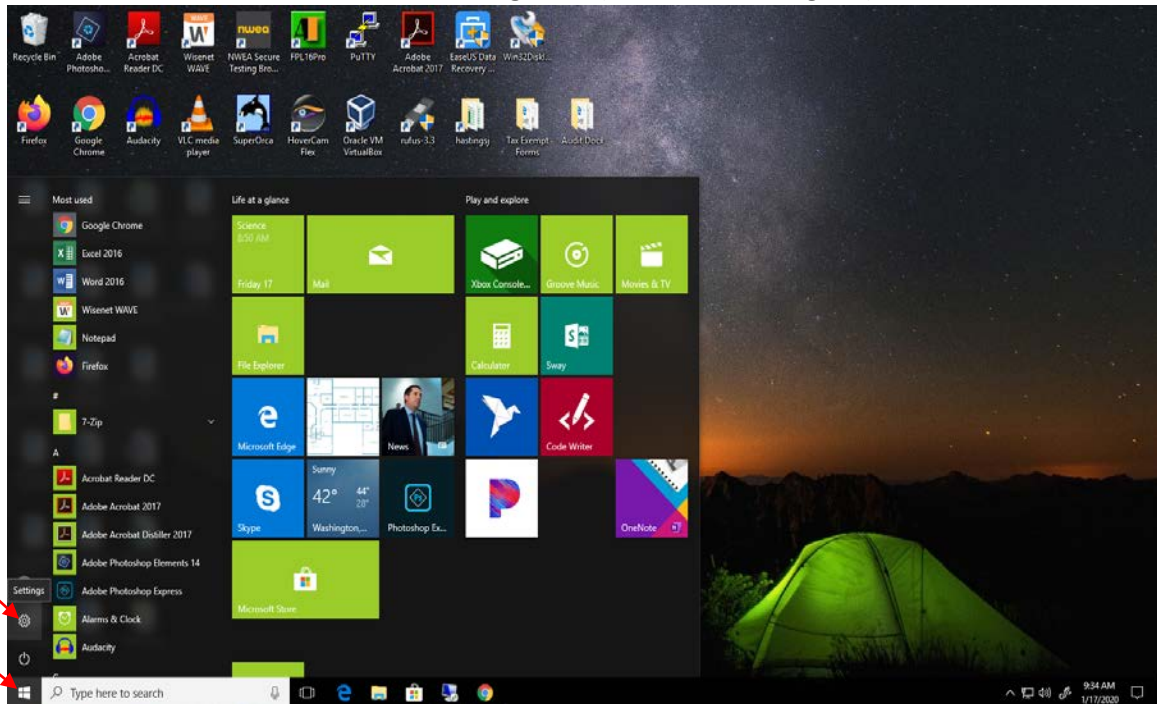
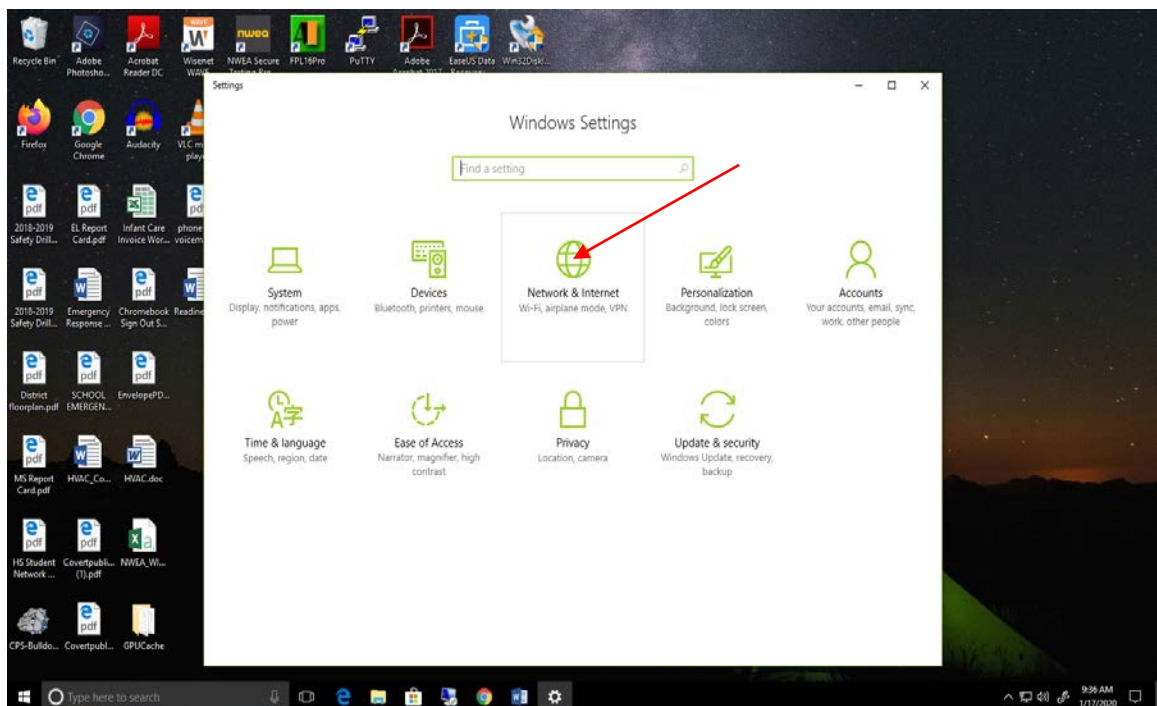


If you get an error on your workstation that all websites can't be reached, try this:

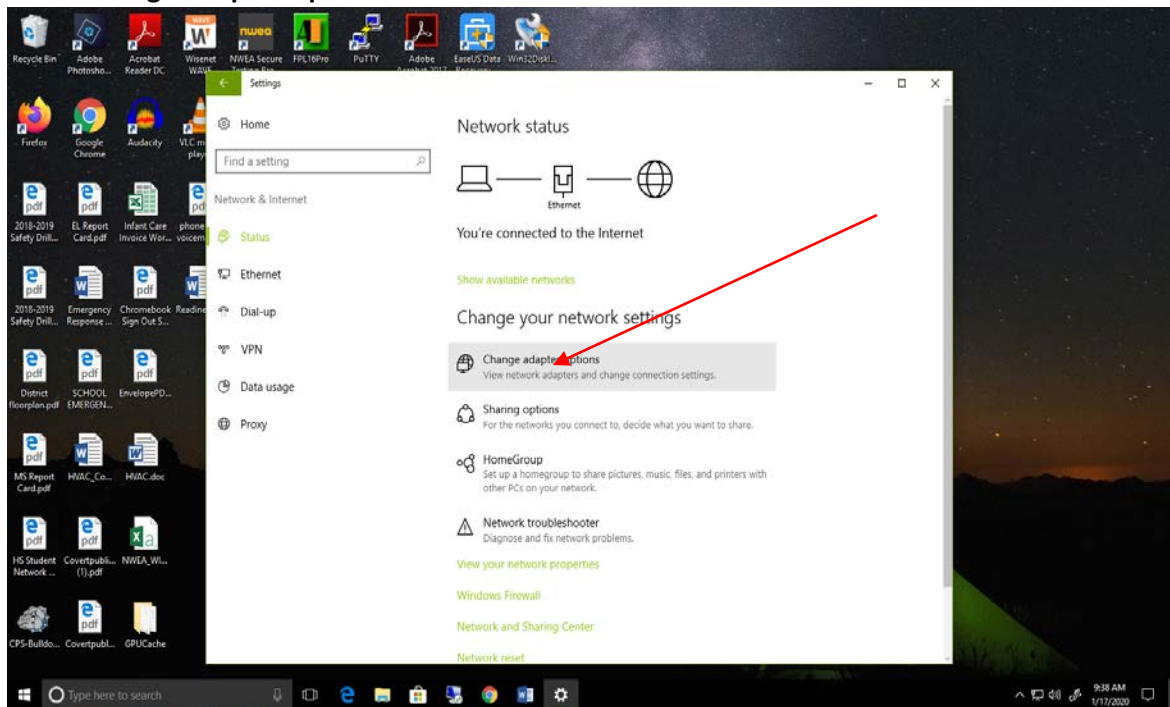
1. Click the **Start** menu, then click the **Settings** icon (looks like a little gear.)



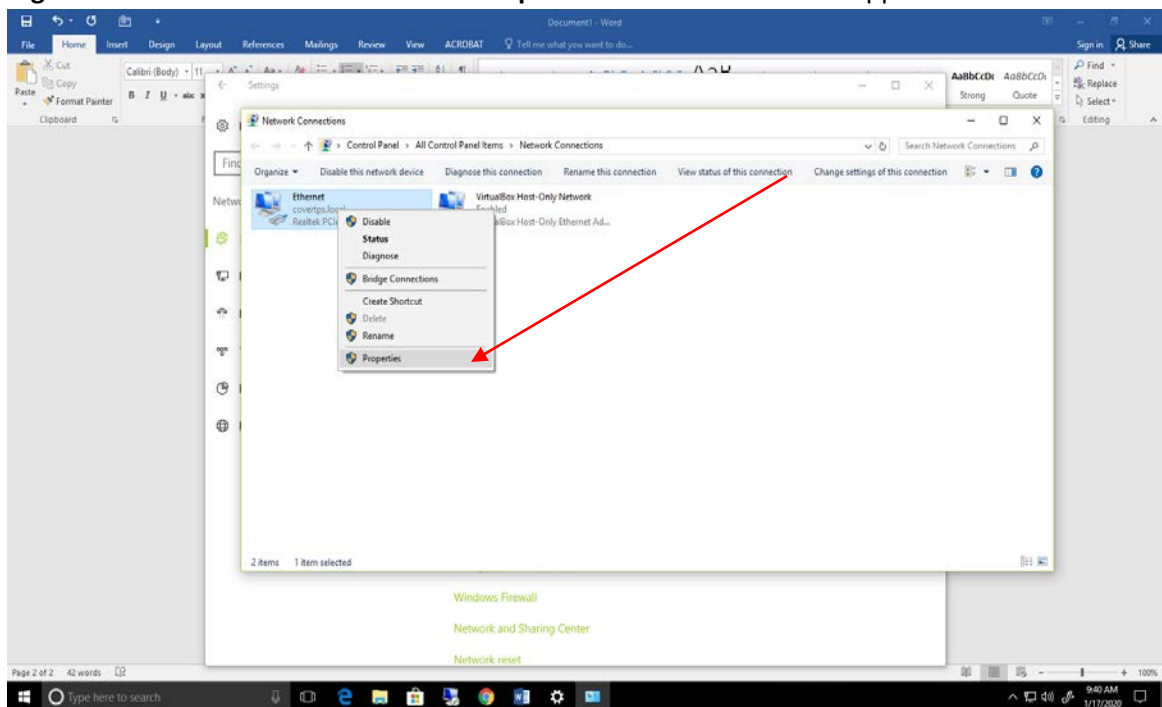
2. Then click **Network & Internet**



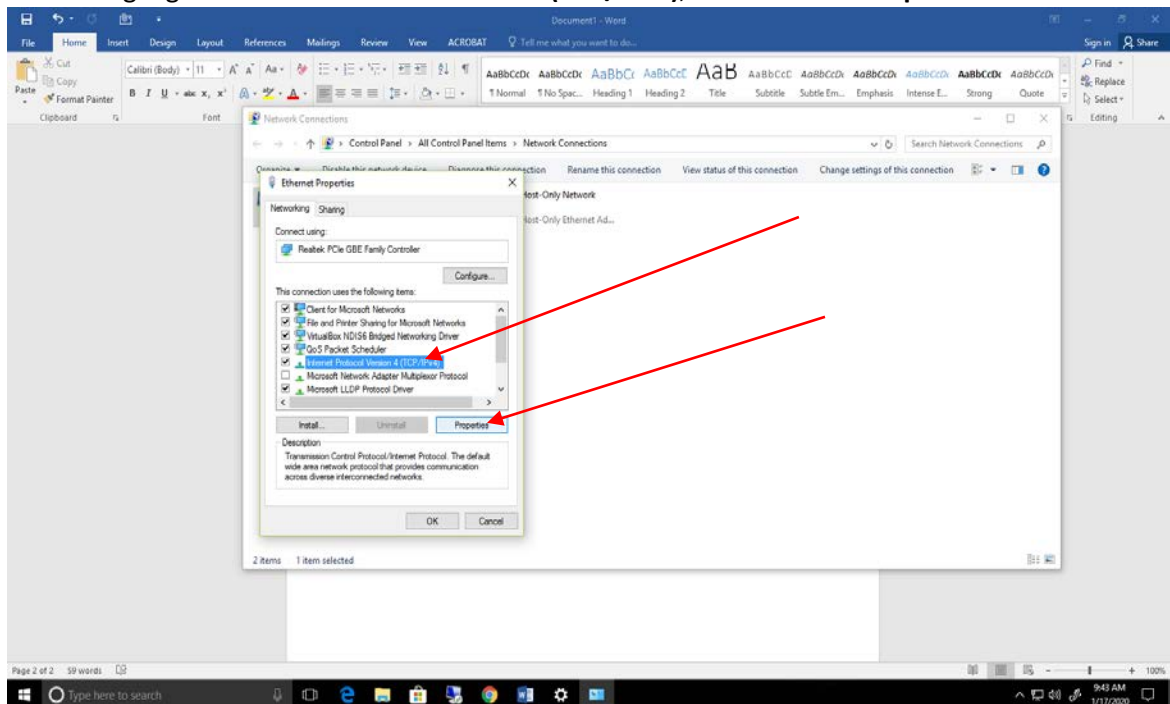
### 3. Select Change Adapter Options



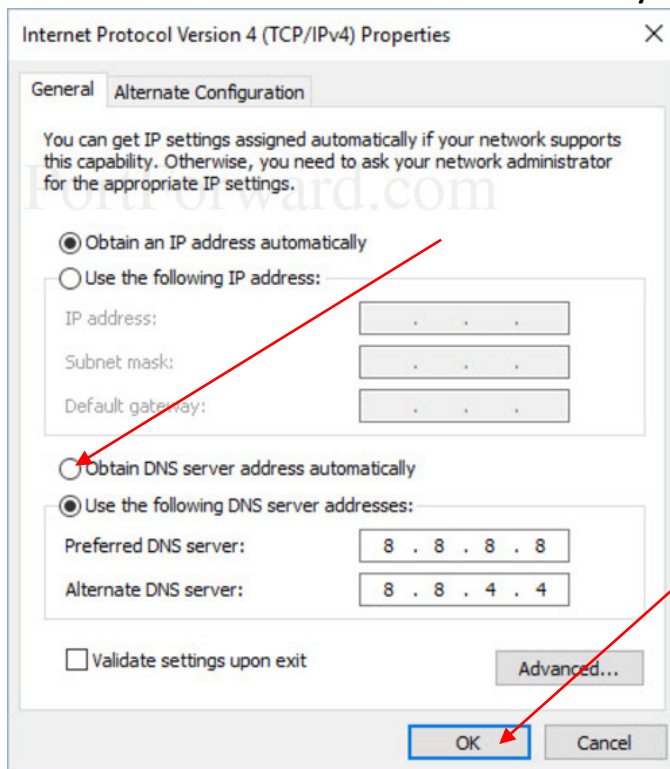
### 4. Right Click on Ethernet icon and select Properties from the menu that appears. Read that twice.



5. Click to highlight **Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)**, then click the **Properties** button.



6. Ensure the **Obtain DNS Server Address Automatically** is selected, then click OK button.



7. Close out of all Windows and your internet access should be restored.
