
If you get an error on your workstation that all websites can't be reached, try this:


1. Click the **Start** menu, then click the **Settings** icon (looks like a little gear.)




2. Then click Network & Internet




3. Select Change Adapter Options




4. Right Click on Ethernet icon and select Properties from the menu that appears. Read that twice.



5. Click to highlight Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4), then click the Properties button.



6. Ensure the **Obtain DNS Server Address Automatically** is selected, then click OK button.



7. Close out of all Windows and your internet access should be restored.
